**Certain Aluminium Extrusions exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China**  
**Application by: Press Metal International Ltd ("PMI")**

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 69: Certain Aluminium Extrusions exported from the People's Republic of China was initiated on 1 February 2018.

For the purpose of obtaining further information in relation to the review, the ADRP Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following materials:

1. the confidential attachments or annexures to Rep 392;
2. the confidential attachments or annexures to Rep 304;
3. the importer information obtained from Press Metal Aluminium Australia Pty Ltd;
4. documents bearing upon or recording the decision or decisions not to select PMI for examination under s 269TACAA, including documents bearing upon or recording:
  - (1) the initial selection of exporters under s 269TACAA(1);
  - (2) the impact on the conduct of the investigation of the failure of exporters previously selected under s 269TACAA(1) to cooperate with the investigation;
  - (3) the selection, during the course of the investigation of Guangdong Nanfang Aluminium Co., Ltd and Xiamen Hongchi Trade Co., Ltd under s 269TACAA(1);

- (4) the selection of Goomax Metal Co. Ltd., Fujian and Foshan Shunde Beijao Jaiwei Aluminium Factory for examination or, alternatively, treatment as cooperative exporters;
