## **ALUMINIUM ROAD WHEELS Exported from the People's Republic of China**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision of the former Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science (the former Parliamentary Secretary), to alter a Dumping Duty and Countervailing Duty Notice following a review enquiry pursuant to section 269ZDB(1) of *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect to ALUMINIUM ROAD WHEELS exported from the People's Republic of China. The former Parliamentary Secretary's decision was published in the Australian on 22 October 2015.

Applications for review were made by Pilotdoer Wheels Co. Ltd (Pilotdoer) and Zhejiang Yueling Co., Ltd (Yueling). A copy of the applications and the ADRP's report (ADRP Report 33) is available on the ADRP website <a href="www.adreviewpanel.gov.au">www.adreviewpanel.gov.au</a>.

The ADRP has recommended that I revoke the reviewable decision and substitute a new decision.

- I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science/Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science have considered and accepted the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations made by the ADRP, including all material findings of fact or law, as set out in ADRP Report 33. In accordance with section 269ZZM (1) of the Act, I revoke the reviewable decision and, with effect from 22 October 2015, substitute a new decision in the same terms except that:
  - (i) in relation to Pilotdoer, the normal value be calculated as recommended in ADRP Report 33 resulting in a dumping margin for Pilotdoer of 2.7%;
  - (ii) in relation to Yueling, the export price and normal value be calculated as recommended in ADRP Report 33 resulting in a dumping margin of 8.3%; and
  - (iii) in relation to Yueling, the subsidy margin is calculated as recommended in the ADRP Report 33 resulting in a countervailing subsidy margin of 3%.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977*, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
