HOT ROLLED STRUCTURAL STEEL SECTIONS exported from JAPAN, THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA, TAIWAN and THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND

NOTICE OF REINVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN FINDINGS

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) received applications from SIAM YAMOTO STEEL CO LTD, NIPPON STEEL, SUMITOMO METAL CORPORATION and ONESTEEL MANUFACTURING PTY LTD for a review of a decision by the then Parliamentary Secretary to publish a dumping duty notice in respect of HOT ROLLED STRUCTURAL STEEL SECTIONS imported from JAPAN, THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA, TAIWAN and THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND.

The ADRP published a notice on 22 January 2015 that it intended to conduct a review in relation to the then Parliamentary Secretary's decision of 7 November 2014.

On 13 April 2015, I wrote to the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission requiring him to reinvestigate certain findings in his report to the Minister (REP223). This request is made in addition to the request made on 23 March 2015. I have asked the Commissioner to report the findings of his reinvestigation by **4 May 2015**.

The ADRP will now be required to provide its report and recommendations for the review to the Parliamentary Secretary **within 30 days after receiving the Commissioner's further reinvestigation report**.
