My name is

I am the owner and sole Director of Shenzhou Yuntong Co.,Ltd (Desinty Ltd).

This is a Hong Kong company with a branch office in China.

I am listed on the ADP Commodities Register as a supplier of aluminium road wheels via Yueling. My CCID No is CCY3644697N.

My submission is in regard to the Yueling (B) submission stating "That the ADC erred by disregarding information provided by Yueling for establishing export prices pursuant to Section 269TAB(4) of the act.

I have been informed by Yueling that the ADC had issues regarding the verification of FOB pricing from their factory.

So I will clarify.

1\ The issue of Shenzhou Yuntong Co Ltd and Destiny Ltd being the same company with 2 names was resolved in the initial investigation in 2012.

The ADC accepted all submitted information regarding this name issue. At no time during the 2015 review was Shenzhou Yuntong Co Ltd contacted by the ADC to be involved with the review.

2\ Shenzhou Yuntong Co,.Ltd was added to APC commodity register on the 13th September 2013 as a supplier from Yueling.

The email attached to the bottom of this email is from - **Stephen Gladwish** - Business and Client Support Administrator | Anti-Dumping Commission.

This email from the ADC accepts my company as a supplier from Yueling. The documentation format that I submitted is the same format as previously approved by the ADC for my company as a supplier of Zhejiang Jinfei Kaida Wheel Co,. Ltd after the original SEF in 2012.

3\ During the original investigation in 2012, "arms length transactions" were reviewed accepted by the ADC regarding the flow of product and documents from my supplying factories in China to my customers in Australia

via my Hong Kong Company. Nothing has changed since 2012. Every FOB invice, every BOL, Packing Declaration and payment is handled in the same was it was prior to the new investigation.

The ADC accepted these documents when they approved my CCID No in 2013. I will follow up this with a secondary email containing the documents.


In addition, the ADC have not removed my company name as an supplier from Yueling. It is still current. So they clearly still accept the working methodology.




