ADRP Review No. 94: Zinc Coated Galvanised Steel exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and Taiwan
Applications by: CITIC Australia Steel Products Pty Ltd (CITIC) and Dongbu Steel Co., Ltd (Dongbu)

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has initiated a review of a decision by the former Assistant Minister for Science, Jobs and Innovation to continue the anti-dumping measures applying to Zinc Coated Galvanised Steel exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and Taiwan (ADN 2018/96).

For the purpose of obtaining further information in relation to the review, the ADRP Member requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

- All confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) (assuming the SEF will otherwise be on the public record).
- All confidential versions of parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the SEF including confidential attachments.
- All confidential attachments to the Final Report (assuming the full Final Report will otherwise be on the public record).

- The confidential version of the application for continuation made by the Australian Industry;
- All other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the applicants including:
 - any correspondence and internal memoranda relating to grounds 1, 2 and 3 of CITIC's application;
 - the verification visit report of the Australian Industry in Review 449 (including any confidential attachments);
 - the verification visit report in respect of Yieh Phui Enterprise Co., Ltd and CITIC in Review 456 (including any confidential attachments);
 - the verification visit report in respect of Dongbu in connection Review 457 (including any confidential attachments); and
 - any other records/documents that contain information about the verification report/s or relating to the grounds of the review applications.
