ADRP Review No. 2020/126
Hollow Structural Sections exported from the Kingdom of Thailand (case 532)

The reinvestigation report in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 2020/126 of hollow structural sections is currently due to the ADRP by 8 June 2021.

You granted a previous extension of time to enable the reinvestigation to be completed. That extension recognised the ongoing high workload of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) and the then anticipated completion of cases that would consequentially allow resources to be devoted to the reinvestigation.

Since that time the Commission has obtained additional data from two of the three relevant exporters from the Kingdom of Thailand. The data has been analysed and the dumping margins re-calculated, however at this stage a quality check of those margins is still underway. The Commission's workload remains high, and since that extension of time was granted the Commission's resources have been devoted to completing a number of other cases which has impacted on our ability to complete this matter.

I therefore request a further extension of an additional 63 days, to 10 August 2021, to provide my reinvestigation report to the ADRP. I anticipate that this time will be used as follows:

9 August 2021	Deliver report to the ADRP.
