**ADRP Review No. 2020/126
Hollow Structural Sections exported from the Kingdom of Thailand (case 532)**

The reinvestigation report in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 2020/126 of hollow structural sections is currently due to the ADRP by 29 July 2021.

I published my preliminary reinvestigation report on 30 June 2021, and provided interested parties until 14 July 2021 to make submissions in response. As previously conveyed to you through the Secretariat, Austube Mills Pty Ltd (one of the Australian industry members) requested and obtained an additional 7 days to make its submission. I have now received that submission, which is more detailed than the Commission had anticipated.

I therefore request a further extension of an additional 21 days, to 19 August 2021, to complete my assessment of that submission and to provide my reinvestigation report to the ADRP. I am confident that the reinvestigation report will be delivered within this proposed timeframe.
