**CERTAIN PREPARED OR PRESERVED TOMATOES  
EXPORTED TO AUSTRALIA FROM THE REPUBLIC OF ITALY**

The reinvestigation report in relation to certain prepared or preserved tomatoes exported to Australia from Italy is currently due to the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) by Thursday, 26 October 2017. As you are aware, I was provided with a timeframe of 45 days to conduct a reinvestigation of certain findings and report to the ADRP as required.

I request an extension of 32 days to the timeframe, to Monday, 27 November 2017, to provide this report to the ADRP. This extension is requested upon the following grounds:

- the reinvestigation case manager needs more time to acquaint themselves with the four grounds that you have requested be reinvestigated, all of which have a significant and complex history;
- the Commission is reallocating its limited resources to support the reinvestigation case manager, noting the complex analysis required to comprehensively address the first ground; and
- the Commission's existing workload means that the reinvestigation case manager is unable to devote themselves solely to this task until 10 October.
