Certain Zinc Coated (Galvanised Steel) Exported from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam
Application by: BlueScope Steel Limited

On 28 August 2017, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) initiated a review of your decision to terminate part of Investigation 370 into the alleged dumping of zinc coated steel exported to Australia from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, and the alleged subsidisation of the goods exported to Australia from India and Vietnam. The decision was the subject of [ADN 2017/98](#).

The ADRP Member requests that Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

1. the partial termination report (TER 370);
2. the application by BlueScope Steel Limited (BlueScope);
3. the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF370);
4. the documents identified by the following numbers on the Commission's electronic public record: 94, 84, 80, 72, 65, 64, 48, 37, 23, 18;
5. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant(s), for example:
 - documents relating to the use of only the sales from the Di An branch of Hoa Sen Group ("Hoa Sen") to determine the normal value for Hoa Sen, including relevant documents from INV 249 and communications between the Commission and Hoa Sen in relation to this issue;
 - documents relating to whether there was a "market situation" in Vietnam; and
6. Any other records/documents that contain information about the verification report/s for Hoa Sen and Nan Kim.

BlueScope submitted only a non-confidential application, which is available on the ADRP website.
