Notice under section 269ZZM(4)
Steel Rod in Coils exported from the People's Republic of China

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision by the former Assistant Minister for Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science (the former Parliamentary Secretary) to publish a notice under section 269TG(1) and section 269TG(2) of the *Customs Act 1901* in relation to Steel Rod in Coils exported from the People's Republic of China by Hunan Valin Xiangtan Iron & Steel Co. Ltd (Hunan Valin), Jiangsu Shagang Group Co., Ltd (Shagang) and Uncooperative Exporters (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 22 April 2016.

Applications for review were made by Hunan Valin, Shagang, Vicmesh Pty Ltd (Vicmesh) and OneSteel Manufacturing Pty Ltd (administrators appointed) (OneSteel). A copy of the applications and the ADRP's report to me (ADRP Report No 40) is available on the ADRP website www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

The ADRP has recommended that I revoke the Reviewable Decision and substitute a new decision.

I, CRAIG LAUNDY, Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science, have considered and accepted the recommendations, and reasons for the recommendations, made by the ADRP in ADRP Report No 40, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in ADRP Report No 40.

Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* and with effect from 22 April 2016, I **revoke** the Reviewable Decision and substitute a new decision in the same terms as the Reviewable Decision except with different normal values in respect of Hunan Valin, Shagang, and Uncooperative Exporters resulting in a dumping margin for Hunan Valin of 40.2% and a dumping margin for Shagang of 36.1% and a dumping margin for Uncooperative Exporters of 49%.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977*, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
