Notice under section 269ZZM (4)

Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel Exported from the Republic of Korea

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision by the then Attorney-General to publish a dumping duty notice in respect of certain aluminium zinc coated steel products exported from the People's Republic of China (China) and Republic of Korea (Korea). The then Attorney-General's decision was published in the Australian on 5 August 2013 (the dumping duty notice).

A full description of the goods which are the subject of the dumping duty notice is available in ACDN 2012/40 (relating to the initiation) and ACDN No. 2012/62 (relating to the clarification of the goods). These ACDNs are available at the Commission's website www.adcommission.gov.au.

The application for review was made by OneSteel Coil Coaters Pty Ltd, and relates only to exports from Korea. A copy of the application and the ADRP Report to me is available on the ADRP website www.adreviewpanel.gov.au

The ADRP recommended that I revoke the reviewable decision and substitute a decision which excludes unchromated steel from the description of the goods that are the subject of the dumping duty notice.

I, ROBERT BALDWIN, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, have considered and accepted, the recommendation of the ADRP, and the reasons for the recommendation including all material findings of fact or law as set out in the ADRP Report.

I therefore VARY the dumping duty notice, with effect from 5 August 2013, by excluding from the description of goods the subject of the notice:

unchromated products that are exported from Korea.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977*, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
