Description: The project is located approximately 20km to the east of Jandowae, in the Western Downs region of Queensland. It is wind power project consisting of 42 wind turbine generators and associated infrastructure (including access tracks, underground and overhead powerlines, electricity substation and, operations and maintenance facilities). The project will connect to a newly constructed 275kV powerline connecting to the Halys substation in the Powerlink network. The project will be constructed by way of an EPC contract.
