Capital expenditure: \$500 million or more

Description: Development, construction and operation of a commercial scale chemical plant that produces green hydrogen using electrolysis and combines it with recycled CO₂ from biomass to produce up to 100 million litres of carbon neutral eFuel per annum. In November 2023 the proposal was at the design and permitting stage, working towards Final Investment Decision and start of construction in 2025. The plant is expected to be operational in 2028.
