Description: The Hunter Gas Pipeline (HGP) is an 833km underground gas pipeline that has planning approval from the NSW and QLD governments. Santos acquired the HGP on 11 August 2022. Once constructed, it will potentially connect the Wallumbilla Gas Supply Hub in Queensland to NSW. The HGP comprises two stages; Stage 1 - Narrabri to Hexham 413km and Stage 2 - Narrabri to Wallumbilla 420km. The Narrabri Gas Project (NGP) in NSW is located on state land in a section of the Pilliga National Park, set aside by the NSW Government for uses including logging and extractive industries. The NGP is expected to supply NSW homes, small businesses, major industries and electricity generators with up to 50 per cent of the state's natural gas needs, bringing significant economic benefits to Narrabri and the surrounding region. The NGP involves the production of natural gas through the progressive development of up to 850 wells connected into processing facilities south of Narrabri at Leewood and Bibblewindi. The NGP will also include the construction of surface facilities and supporting infrastructure.
