Description: 55 Pitt Street is a new 55storey commercial tower delivering approximately 70,000m² of office space, groundfloor retail, and public realm upgrades, along with improvements to neighbouring utility buildings. Mirvac Constructions Pty Limited will act as Head Contractor for the Mirvac project proponents, managing the project and overseeing procurement activities in line with the approved AIP Plan. Procurement for major building elements and services commenced in 2021, with project completion expected by the end of 2027. Mirvac does not anticipate requiring goods or services valued at \$1 million or more during the initial twoyear operations phase.
