Description: The project is located east of Muswellbrook in NSW. It is a wind power project consisting of up to 56 wind turbine generators and associated infrastructure (including access tracks, underground and overhead powerlines, an electricity substation and operations and maintenance facilities and buildings). As at April 2026 the project has been approved by both state and federal government. All procurement entities that are appointed will be contractually required to comply with, and report against, the approved AIP plan.
