Description: The Kerrs Creek wind farm project involves the engineering, design, procurement, transport, installation, and commissioning of up to 55 wind turbine generators, including all associated civil and electrical balance of plant for the wind farm. The project is anticipated to begin construction in 2027 and the construction period is estimated to last between 2-3 years. The Project location was chosen for its good wind speeds, proximity to transmission lines, accessibility to ports and town facilities, as well as our ability to achieve the project goals with minimal environmental and community impacts. The procurement strategy is to tender to a range of respected wind turbine OEMs and balance of plant contractors, in order to deliver a project that will provide clean and reliable electricity power to approximately 160,000 homes.
