Name: Logan West Upgrade Project

Location: Southeast Queensland

Type: Land transport facility

Purpose: Upgrade existing facility

Capital expenditure: \$500 million or more

Description: Transurban is partnering with the Queensland Government (via the Department of Transport and Main Roads) to develop plans to upgrade approximately 10km of the western section of the Logan Motorway, between Formation Street and the Mount Lindesay Highway. The proposed project involves adding an additional lane in each direction between the Centenary Motorway and the Mount Lindesay Highway, upgrades to key motorway interchanges, including Formation Street, and the installation of smart motorway technology. The project is co-funded by Transurban and the Queensland Government. Procurement and construction is forecast to occur from December 2026 via a Design and Construct head contractor. The project is targeting completion by November 2030, or sooner.
