## Project details

Name: Ungula Wind Farm

Location: 1360 Twelve Mile Road, Wuuluman NSW 2820

Type: Electricity facility

Purpose: Establish new facility

Capital expenditure: \$500 million - \$1 billion

Description: Construction of a new Wind Farm The Ungula Wind Farm is located 14km due east of Wellington, NSW within the Central-West Orana Renewable Energy Zone. 69 wind turbines to be constructed with the full windfarm output of 400MW powering around 200,000 standard homes. It is expected that >260 jobs will be created during construction, along with 10-15 operational jobs for the initial 30 years operational life. Ungula Windfarm will be developed, owned and operated by Squadron Energy (SQE) via its nominated project proponent UWF Trust. UWF Trust has engaged a joint venture consortium construction team to deliver the project, the three parties that are known as GECNJV consists of: GE Renewable Energy Australia Pty Ltd (General Electric) ACN 003 760 790 who will supply, install and commission the turbines Consolidated Power Projects Australia Pty Ltd (CCP) ABN 18 075 411 219 will perform the Balance of Plant - Electrical (BoPE), which involves all of the underground and overhead cabling and connection into the switchyard. Nacap Pty Ltd (Nacap) ABN 33 006 306 994 will perform the Balance of Plant - Civil (BoPC) which will include all of the access roads, crane pads and equipment laydown areas plus the foundations for the turbines (excavation, reinforcement, form and concrete pouring) During Operations, GE will be engaged by SQE to operate and maintain the turbines under a Facilities Services Agreement (FSA) and for Civil maintenance, SQE will engage directly with minor civil subcontractors to perform these works. Estimated procurement phase would take place in parallel with the design phase. Estimated to be a period of 6 months from Notice to Proceed (NTP) which is from 20 December 2023. It will be a contractual requirement of GECNJV to comply and report on the AIP Plan during the Construction phase and GE during the Operational phase of the project.
