The proposed project would incorporate a wind farm with up to 170 turbines and a battery storage facility.

It is located about 22 kilometres east of Theodore and is proposed to be connected to the transmission network via the Banana Range Wind Farm Connection project 275 kV transmission line approximately 50 km north of the Project.

The transmission line will be under separate ownership and subject to separate approvals.

The Theodore Wind Farm will result in the generation of clean energy, assisting Queensland to meet its 70% renewable energy target by 2032 as part of the Queensland Energy and Jobs Plan, provide a revenue for involved landholders for up to 35+ years, and provide approximately 300-500 construction jobs during the peak phase and approximately 10-50 ongoing full time equivalent (FTE) jobs.
