Description:

The Bulli Creek Stage 1 Project (BC1 or the Project) is a high-voltage-coupled hybrid renewable energy project located approximately 4 km from Powerlink Queensland's Bulli Creek 330 kV substation and approximately 150 km south-west of Toowoomba, Queensland. BC1 represents the first stage of the Bulli Creek Clean Energy Park (BCCEP).

Developed by Genex Power Pty Ltd (Genex), the Project will comprise a 300 MW solar photovoltaic generation facility and a 425 MW / 1,700 MWh battery energy storage system (BESS). BC1 represents a reconfiguration and integration of the previously proposed 775 MW Bulli Creek Stage 1 Solar Project and the 600 MW / 2,400 MWh Bulli Creek Battery Project, which were previously proposed as Stages 1 and 2 of the BCCEP.

Key Project infrastructure will include:

- Solar modules;
- BESS and associated equipment;
- Transformers;
- Operations and maintenance facilities;
- Access roads;
- Medium voltage and high voltage electrical reticulation; and
- Fencing.

The Project is expected to be delivered under a split-contracting procurement model. The solar engineering, procurement and construction works and the BESS balance-of-plant works will be delivered under a combined solar EPC and BESS BoP contract. The supply and installation of the BESS and associated equipment will be delivered under a separate supply agreement with a BESS original equipment manufacturer.

Major procurement and construction activities are expected to commence in 2028 following Financial Close and the issue of the relevant notices to proceed.

Financial Close is currently targeted for the first quarter of 2028, with construction commencing thereafter and commercial operations targeted for the third quarter of 2030.
