Description:

RWE is working on developing a renewable energy project near Dunmore in southern QLD, in the vicinity of the Western Downs and Toowoomba Regional Councils.

The proposed project would incorporate a wind farm with up to 135 wind turbines with the final number subject to the outcomes of various specialist studies. A battery energy storage system will also be included as part of the project.

The project is currently in the planning and development phase. The projects Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation referral has been submitted and we are working towards submitting a Development Application later this year.

Construction of the project is expected to take two to three years and require a workforce of about 500 people at peak periods.
