The project is located west of Mt Morgan and east of Westwood, about 35km SW of Rockhampton in Queensland. Stage 1 consists of 38 wind turbine generators and associated infrastructure (including access tracks, underground and overhead powerlines, an electricity substation and operations and maintenance facilities). The project has been granted approval by the Queensland Government and the Commonwealth Government under the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999. Construction is expected to commence in late 2024 and then moving into operations late 2027
