The proposed project involves construction of a nominal 250 MW gas-fired (natural gas, and capability for blending natural gas, biomethane, an hydrogen), fast-start reciprocating internal combustion engine (RICE) peaking plant, and connections to associated infrastructure. The facility is intended to be situated on land at 2 Memorial Drive, Swanbank, in Queensland. Relevant procurement activities are expected to be conducted throughout 2026 and beyond, in preparation for completion and commercial opera to commence during 2033.
