The Tarong West Wind Farm will consist of 97 wind turbines and associated infrastructure including the following:
wind turbine foundations and hardstand areas,
three permanent and four temporary (during construction period only) meteorological masts,
internal electrical reticulation consisting of overhead lines and underground cabling,
access tracks including widening sections of Ironpot Road,
on-site connection to existing 275 kilovolt transmission line,
electrical substations to facilitate connection of the project to the grid,
construction compounds and laydown areas,
site compounds,
operations and maintenance facilities,
batching plant,
borrow pits, and
washdown areas.
Construction is currently planned to start in 2027. Energisation is expected in 2030.
