DESCRIPTION OF PATTERN




FIGURE 1/2A/1 - 4

The pattern (see Figure 1) is a price-computing fabric-measuring instrument approved in the States of Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria and Western Australia, which has been modified for use with decimal currency.

The modification consists of substituting a price-computing chart (see Figure 2) marked in decimal currency for the original sterling chart. The chart is marked D 59. It has a series of computed price columns based on price rates ranging from 19 cents to \$3.75 per yard.

DESCRIPTION OF VARIANT

1. Having the D 59 chart fitted to other price-computing instruments made by the abovementioned manufacturer and approved in the abovementioned States.

GENERAL NOTES

Notice of approval of the pattern and variant was given in Memorandum of Approval No 14 dated 20th September, 1966.

The pattern modified as described was approved in Victorian Notice of Approval No 556.

2. price-computing charts with a price range of \$0,11 to \$2,50 per metre and \$0,25 to \$9,75 per metre, as illustrated in Figures 4 and 5.


