A One Litre Measure and Variants.

This is to certify that the pattern and variants of the measure described in this Certificate have been examined by the National Standards Commission under the provisions of the abovementioned Regulations and have been approved as being suitable for use for trade.

Approval of specific variants, namely 5, 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 ml inverted conical dispensing measures, was granted on 18th October 1966 (Certificate No 4/3/1)*; approval of the pattern and remaining variants was granted on 16th August 1972.

DESCRIPTION OF PATTERN. The pattern is of a 1 litre measure made of glass, having a cylindrical form, as described in the General Specifications for Measuring Instruments to be Used for Trade.

DESCRIPTION OF VARIANTS. In other forms and denominations as described in the following Parts of the General Specifications:

1. Part 5A — Liquid Measures (exempting the provisions for specified sizes of beverage glasses);
2. Part 5B — Lubricating Oil Bottles;
3. Part 5C — Dispensing Measures.
