DESCRIPTION

The pattern is a modification of the Gilbarco Proportional Blending Dispenser T142A approved under Victorian Notice No 499, fitted with remote Gilbarco Submerged Turbine Pump T221 (Victorian Notice No 309) and two air separators as fitted to the Gilbarco T131 Dispenser described in Victorian Notice No 309.
