DESCRIPTION

The pattern is a modification of an instrument described in Victorian Certificates of Approval Nos 527, 544, 548, 557 and 597. The modification consists of having the pump and hose reel rewind mechanism driven by an hydraulic slave motor powered by an hydraulic pump driven from a power take-off from the vehicle engine.

SCHEDULE OF VARIANTS

1. Having the pump and hose reel rewind mechanism driven by any type of prime mover through any type of drive.
