This is to certify that the pattern and variants of the abovementioned weighing instrument have been approved under the Weights and Measures (Patterns of Instruments) Regulations as being suitable for use for trade when converted to read in metric units in accordance with Appendix 8 of the General Specifications for Measuring Instruments to be Used for Trade.

Date of Approval: 22 February 1974

Description of Pattern:

The pattern is of a self-indicating weighing instrument which comprises a basework consisting of four straight main levers, two longitudinal transfer levers and one transverse transfer lever, coupled to a five-unit-weight self-indicating headwork. The resistant is a double-pendulum type, with floating fulcrums.
