#### DESCRIPTION

The pattern (see Figure 1) is a modification of the Hammond Model 80L self-indicating counter machine of 4 lb capacity, approved in all States, fitted with weight charts of 4 lb by  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz graduations and, on the vendor's side, with a chart and indicator for the computation of prices in shillings and pence.

The pattern is an instrument of the Roberval type. Movement of the lever is transmitted to a pendulum resistant mechanism to which is attached two indicators, one on the purchaser's side and the other on the vendor's side.

The modification consists of the fitting of a price-computing chart and indicator for price rates from 1 to 105 cents per pound on the vendor's side, the prices and price rates being in black on a white background. The chart and indicator are each marked "H10" (see Figure 2).

#### SCHEDULE OF VARIANTS

- 1. An instrument of 5 lb capacity fitted with weight charts of capacity 5 lb by ½ oz graduations and on the vendor's side with a price-computing chart and indicator for price rates from 1 to 65 cents per pound, the prices and price rates being in black on a white background. The chart and indicator are each marked "H11" (see Figure 3).
- 2. An instrument of 2 lb capacity fitted with weight charts of capacity 2 lb by \( \frac{1}{4} \) oz graduations and on the vendor's side with a price-computing chart and indicator for price rates from 1 to 105 cents per pound, the prices and price rates being in black on a white background. The chart and indicator are each marked "H13" (see Figure 4).
- 3. An instrument similar to variant 2 with a price-computing chart and indicator for price rates from 1 to 155 cents per pound. The chart and indicator are each marked "H15" (see Figure 5).

4. Having the charts and indicators described in the pattern or variant 1 or 2 or 3 fitted to other State-approved instruments.




FIGURE 6/4D/2 - 5
